Important Reminder: June 20th - Projected Image Challenge given by Stuart Robinson FRPS, "My changing Life/My changing World" Stuart has asked us to create a Picture story with 7-10 images over 6-8 months or so which would be suitable to place in a Sunday Magazine. Photoshop (or other software) may only be used for slight improvement in Levels. Curves and Saturation otherwise manipulation. No cloning, no removal of objects and no adding in either. If possible all framing, composition etc. should be done in camera. Remember titles should be appropriate to the Images. Images should be in jpeg format but if shooting in raw they need to be converted to jpeg and meet our usual projection requirements - delivered in a named folder to Avril Candler by 13th June – 15th at the latest.

PAGB Great British Cup

The Great British Cup is the largest inter-club event in the world. It is an annual projected digital image competition open to all PAGB affiliated clubs. The competition is split into three sections i.e. an Open section for larger clubs, a Small Clubs section and a section for Natural History images. We've entered the Small Clubs and Natural History sections. Images have been chosen from the selection pool comprising images from 'old' (!) and new members. Judging takes place in February without an audience. Results will be published almost immediately.

Chilterns Championship Day

Championship Day is on **Sunday 19th March** at Amersham. (Drake Hall, Amersham Community Centre, Chiltern Avenue, HP6 5AH). Detailed timing will be published later. Entrance £5 (with a raffle). It comprises the Chilterns Hundred Members Exhibition, Print and Projected Championships.

The Championship Day is an important chance to see the work from many other Clubs, all judged to national standard.

Chilterns Hundred Members Exhibition:

Every member has the opportunity to choose one projected image for inclusion by the Club in this event. Please hand in your image by or on 7th February. The event is expected to have Photographic Alliance Patronage with the award of Gold, Silver and Bronze medals, and three Ribbons. After the event, all the images are put on a CD which is distributed to all Chilterns region Clubs. We will show the CD at the Club later in the year.

Print Championship: The Club needs to select 15 prints for this event. Please hand in prints for selection by or on **7**th **February.**

Projected Championship: The Club will select 15 projected images from the available stock. Additional entries for your stock can be handed in by or on **7**th **February.**

Chilterns Rosebowl Day - 23rd April

The event (previously known as "The Big Day!") will take place from 1.30pm at Drake Hall, Amersham Entrance is £5, and a raffle.

Rosebowl Final: follows the AGM and talk by Linda Bembridge; the final is between the top twelve Clubs from the league matches. No additional entries are required from members.
