The Club collects and holds personal information about members. Personal contact details are used only for the administration of the Club, and are distributed only to Committee members, and to others approved by the Committee for specific purposes.

Contact details may be held about prospective members while they decide whether to join.

The Club may retain historical archives for example but not limited to, records of meetings, handbooks, catalogues, awards and other event results.
