2002: Rule change: Revert to an external judge for Round One (same as 1978-1998).

1999: Rule change as an emergency, and continued for 2000 and 2001.

In the first round, participating clubs each appoint a judge. The panel of judges scores all prints (except those from their own club).

The 10 highest scoring prints go through to the final with an external judge.

2001: Rule change: Open Subject, and no longer restricted to Pictorial

1978: Revised Rules: Clubs submit any number of prints up to a maximum quota.

Only one print per author. The quota is set at 48-50 prints overall (eg 8x6, 7x7, 6x8).

In the first round, an external judge selects 10 prints from all entered.

In the second round, an external judge selects 1 print from the 10 shortlisted.

The trophy is awarded to the winning author.
